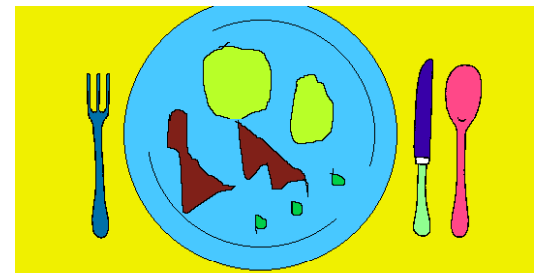


Use Colour Magic at Yellow, Green or Blue Level Select 'Exercises' to see a list of ready made activities which support :-

The 'fill' tool to 'colour in'.

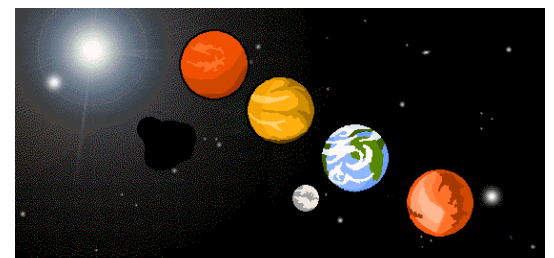
Example files are :- Dinner, Bus, Airport, Seaside, Windowbox

### Painting Landscapes - very simply

Use the largest paint brush. Paint horizontal stripes in different shades of blue from the top of the painting area. About half way down change to using different shades of green so that you get a **background landscape effect**. Narrow the brush and draw a few lines to represent fences or hedges

Click on the **Stamps tool**.

The index to the topic bank appears

Choose pictures from Farmyard, farmyard animals etc to add to the landscape.



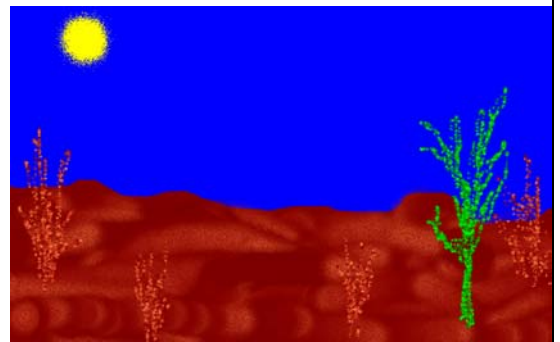
### Using the Stamps - Dinosaurs

All children love the stamps! Encourage them to use them as effectively as possible by making a suitable background and using the different sized stamps to show perspective. Placing vegetation in front of creatures looks more realistic. The text tool allows a name and/or title to be added on.



**Landscape**

Use fill tool to paint sky. Draw horizon in brown and fill rest of ground. Choose the Options menu - Edit Colour Cauldrons and choose Browns. Use the Chalk brush (big size). Click on the rainbow colour (this paints with the Colour Cauldron you have chosen). Paint over the ground colour. Use the spray tool, high density (LHS) and slow mouse movements to draw the vegetation. To get the green vegetation, choose Greens from the Colour Cauldron. The sun is sprayed on with a low density (RHS) spray

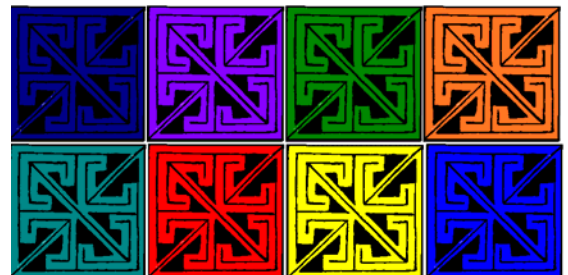


**Paint a landscape using shades of blue and green** (or other colours) Smudge these with the 'smudge' paint tool. Find some stamps to add which suit your topic



**Using the Stamps - Patterns**

Stamp on a Celtic pattern, using careful mouse control to line up the tiles. Fill with different colours.



**Investigate the use of the Stamp tool** together with the **Symmetry tool** on the top tool bar.
